What will your duties be as an Intern in Sydney?

What are the qualifications required?

Since the internship is unpaid you have to be able to finance your studies through CSN/scholarships etc. The University must act as principal (huvudman) during the internship (be responsible for insurances etc.)
- Fluency in Swedish and English is a must.
- Sales experience, for example sales by phone, is preferable
- Outgoing and dedicated, the internship presupposes a large amount of own responsibility
- Possess initiative drive and be result focused
