

Workspace guidelines

All doctoral students are entitled to a workplace at the department, as well as access to basic administrative resources (such as IT, copy machines, coffee, etc.).

1. Computer and software regulations

Software

- Standard programs at the School are: Windows, Office and antivirus software.
- Other programs requested by a doctoral student employed by the School should be funded through FIFF-D or through external sources of funding.

Hardware

- New doctoral students are offered a computer. The IT unit determines the model, configuration and appropriate standard software.
- If the computer is purchased with research, project or external funding, the IT unit will request a service agreement or a favourable warranty. In this case, the IT unit should be consulted to select the model and operating system, based on user needs and compatibility with our network.

Private computers

- Private computers brought to the workplace cannot be connected to the department network. However, it is possible to connect to the University's wireless network. Questions regarding the wireless network can be directed to IT-Media, helpdesk@it.su.se, 08-161999
