International two-year Master's Program in Psychology

The International Master's Program is very diverse and offers you the opportunity to select courses that suit your interests not only in psychology but also in other areas. The program is a coherent degree program that comprises 120 ECTS credits, meaning four semesters of full-time studies divided into four main blocks:

- Block A: 30 ECTS of compulsory courses.
- Block B: 30 ECTS of elective courses in psychology.
- Block C: 30 ECTS of entirely elective courses.
- Block D: 30 ECTS Master's thesis.

The program's overall objective is to provide a broad and in-depth knowledge base within the field of psychology. Courses are offered, for example, in social psychology, evolutionary psychology, cognition, biological psychology, developmental psychology and work and organizational psychology.

The program also includes research methodology, which may be of use in the labour market in general, but also as a preparation for further studies at the doctoral level in psychology.

You can study all courses at the Department of Psychology if you wish, but you can also take some courses at other departments at Stockholm University, or even at other universities - in Sweden or abroad.

30 ECTS of entirely elective courses such as exchange studies or courses in other fields of study may be included in your degree.
