



Application SBS exchange programme

> WHEN? Fall

Placement list available in December

Application round: **January 15 - February 15**

> WHEN? **Spring**

Placement list available in June

Application Deadline: August 15 - September 15

Eligibility

You are eligible to take part in the study abroad exchange program if you are:

Enrolled as a student at SBS

Bachelor

- Earned at least 60 ECTS prior to departure (undergraduate students)
- Passed 7 out of 8 courses within your SBS programme at the time of application

Master

• At the time of application master students must have successfully passed three (3) out of four (4) courses from the first semester in the master programme.



Where can I go?

More than 100 Partner universities worldwide

 A list of available placements for coming semester about one month before before the application round starts





Application process

- 1. Online application (list 5 universities)
- 2. Letter of motivation (in English): 300-500 words
- Language proficiency certificate: -IELTS/TOEFL or Swedish 'gymansiebetyg'



Application process NOTE!

- If the application does not fulfill the requirements, for example: submitting language requirements or a work experience certificate for a specific school you have applied for, the application for that school will not be considered.
- If the application is incomplete, the application will not be considered
- No individual feedback will be provided.



Selection process

- Students are ranked based on academic achievements at SBS(see website for details)
- Point breakdown: A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1.
- Points are also awarded for accredited extra-curriculars

- Letter of motivation



Nomination process

- Selection result by email one week after deadline
- International office will nominate you to partner university
- APPLY to the partner university
- Course selection, visa, applying for housing ...
- Attend pre-departure workshop

What is MFS?





Collect data or conduct a field study for an essay or a degree project

- Sholarship programme funded by Sida: 27 000 SEK
- All research topic and degree
- Students on bachelor's or master's level
- Field study in less developed country during at least eight weeks (56 days).
- Gain international experience, new perspectives, a deeper understanding of yourself and about issues on socio-economic development with a global perspective.
- Supervisor in Sweden and contact person in host country.
