”Enforcement and Sanctions in Environmental Law”

Invitation and Call for Papers

Stockholm Environmental Law and Policy Centre, at Stockholm University, organises the 6th NELN Workshop, funded by Nordforsk.

This workshop is devoted to enforcement and sanctions. For the purpose of the workshop these concepts should be given a broad understanding. *Enforcement* includes means and procedures for authorities as well as for members of the public to have existing laws applied against actors affecting health, environment and natural resources. In some contexts enforcement also embraces means of implementation. *Sanctions* include not only penal and administrative sanctions, but also, where relevant, sanctions imposed by members of the public (e.g. in terms of civil liability). Even informal sanctions in relation to environmental law fit with the topic of the workshop. Finally, papers on international, supranational and transnational aspects of enforcement and sanctions are encouraged.

Papers and presentations related to this topic are welcome. While papers by PhD students are particularly appreciated, also papers by other participants may be approved. It is possible to attend the workshop without presenting papers. However, if for budget reasons, not all applications can be approved, preference will be given to those intended to present papers.

Deadline for application to the workshop is **1 September 2005**. Send application to Mia Lundgren (see below). Please use the Registration form for the application, and submit an abstract of the proposed presentation (approx. ½ page) as well as costs for travel.

Costs: Nordforsk/NELN will cover accommodation, lunches Thursday and Friday, and dinner Thursday evening for all participants. Travel costs will be reimbursed within the framework given by the budget for the participants coming from the Nordic and Baltic countries. A limited number of participants from other countries may also be eligible for refund of travelling costs. Each participant will have to make travel arrangements individually, and is expected to travel economy class and use collective transport, to keep costs down, unless otherwise is agreed beforehand with the organiser. If problems arise (on prices etc.), please contact Mia Lundgren (see below). Please make sure to keep tickets/invoices for reimbursement (no exception).
