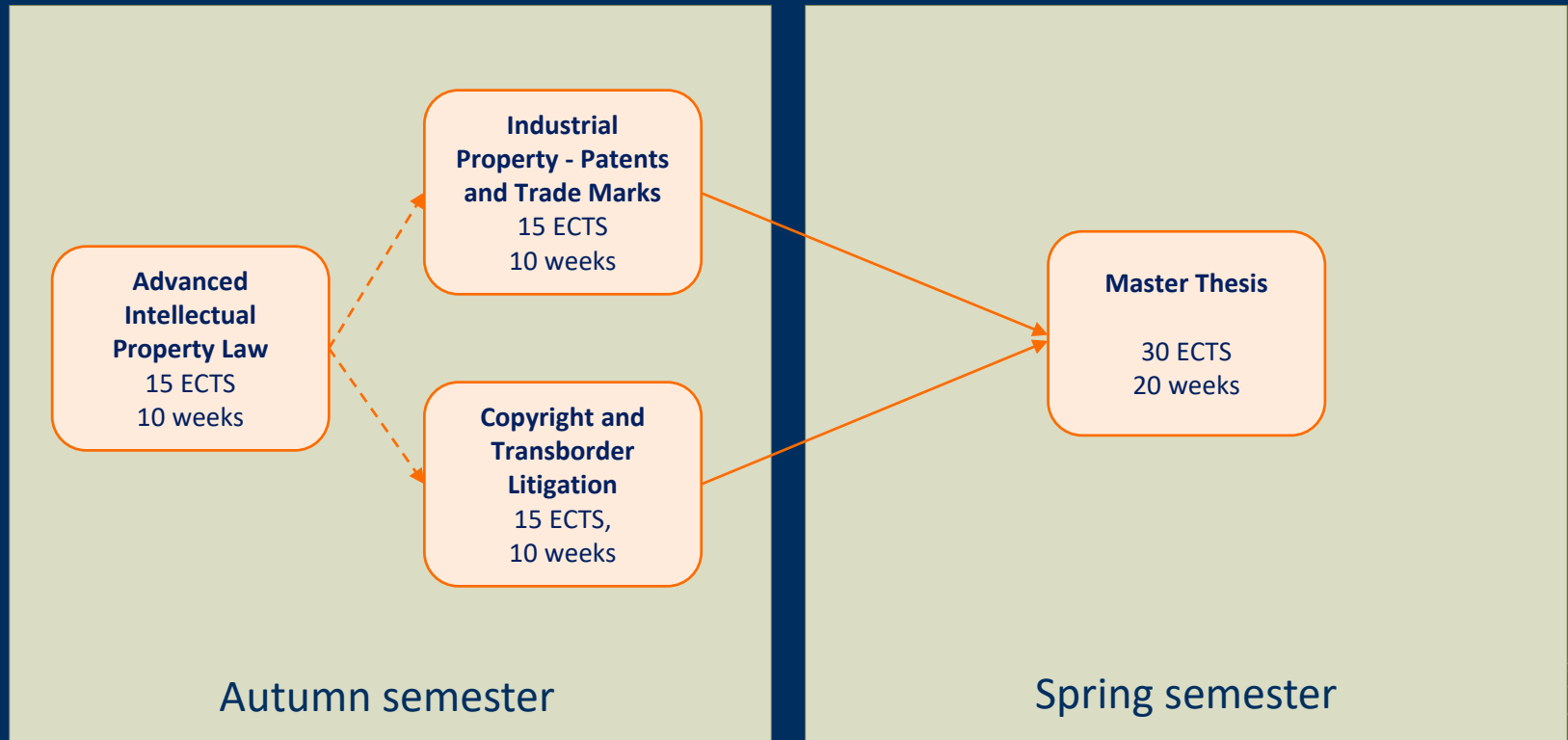

- **Module 1:** Advanced Intellectual Property Law
Introduction to all IPRs, practical application and policy considerations
- **Module 2A:** Industrial Property – Patents and Trade Marks
A specialization course on patent and trademark law, with a special focus on certain industries, such as the pharmaceutical, biotech industry, software industry as well as the fashion industry
- **Module 2B:** Copyright and Transborder Litigation
A specialization course in copyright and transborder litigation.
- **Module 3:** Master Thesis
A term dedicated to methodological discussions and writing a masters thesis in the field of Intellectual Property Rights
