

Review of achievements and material to be included in doctoral theses at MBW

The IPS follow-up committee shall review the achievements of the PhD student and the papers that are to be included in the doctoral thesis with the aim of issuing a recommendation to proceed or not with the thesis defence.

The requirements for a positive recommendation are:

- 1) the PhD student must have obtained at least 50 credits from courses and other theoretical activities at the time of the defence of the thesis,*
- 2) the extent and the quality of the papers included in the thesis should be at the level expected after four years of full-time doctoral studies,*
- 3) the contribution of the PhD student to each of the papers should be clearly discerned.*

Instructions:

The PhD student should fill in this form and write a list of articles/manuscripts that are to be included in the thesis, including the details specified below. The form and the list should be sent by e-mail to the members of the ISP committee and to Alexander Malmstedt, alexander.malmstedt@su.se.

The ISP committee should issue a recommendation using the form "Recommendation-Decision".
