







The seminars on international labour standards were more like lectures. I think the course could benefit from one lecture on the topic and then on seminar which slow more in depth discussions.

The course is very heavy with both an exam and an essay, maybe consider if both is needed.

Maybe add one or two lectures

Having more examples of old tests to practice on before the exam.

I would prefer a bit more the EU-internal-perspective. Some of the literature should be updated, especially some of the texts from "Migrants at work". To be able to understand problems and aims with regulations and directives its important to have updated information about the situation today to understand the context. For some seminars we were asked to study the directions carefully. Its hard to do that and understand them, unless you have a context to relate to.

I would suggest sending the material (compendium) to a publisher so it can be printed and bought at Akademibokhandeln. Sometimes the preparation material for seminars was a little too comprehensive, whereas I would be stressed to read it all and not have time to fully understand the material or gain a deeper understanding of the topics of a few texts.
