Didn't even open the Handbook on European Data Protection Law - wasn't necessary since we only had one lecture about GDPR so the whole book felt unnecessary.



As mentioned under p. 13 I found that the written examination questions should have been balanced differently against the time an adequate answer required. Particularly since writing and expressing oneself in English takes slightly longer if it's your second language.
