§ 7	Report from the External Science Advisory Group, ESAG
	The chair of the External Science Advisory Group, ESAG, Raymond T. Pierrehumbert, gave a summary of ESAG recommendations for the Bolin Centre. The ESAG will send a written report to the Board.
§ 8	Information/ Discussion
	 a) Per capsulum decision to recommend Prof Veerabhadan Ramanathan as the Bolin Climate Lecturer in 2018. Prof Veerabhadan Ramanathan has been invited on behalf of the Faculty of Science as the Bolin Climate Lecturer in 2018. The lecture will be held 21 May 2018. Save the date! b) Information about the Climate Research School HC Hansson would like to initiate a discussion about the role of the CRS in the Bolin Centre. The budget for the CRS has been cut down and this affects the activities that can be conducted. The board suggested asking HC Hansson to come to the next board meeting
	and present the CRS. c) Financing of SNIC SNIC offers among other things climate modeling infrastructure which many Bolin Center researchers use. SNIC has been financed as a national infrastructure by VR previously. Starting in 2018, universities will be required to help finance this infrastructure. For Stockholm University, this cost is 13.2 million SEK of which half will be covered centrally and half must be covered by departments. Of this 6.6 million SEK, 4.7 MSEK will be covered by in kind contributions, but 1.9 MSEK must come from departments directly. Based on user statistics, MISU will be hit by the brunt of this, since MISU-scientists are PIs on the applications that provide much of computational resources for the whole Bolin Centre, including the Rossby Centre. Considering that there is a broad use of the climate modeling infrastructure provided by SNIC within the Bolin Centre, this is not reasonable for the future. The board discussed this matter and concluded that this will be an item at the next board meeting. Erik Kjellström will prepare and share information prior to the next board meeting. d) The Bolin Centre database: A proposal for a new Core Facility A proposal has been written and will be circulated to the Bolin Centre board members in time for discussion at the next board meeting. If approved it will then be sent to the Faculty of Science as a proposal for a new Core Facility.
