f) Mission to SMHI and the Environmental Protection Agency (Naturvårdsverket) from the government to investigate and evaluate the opportunities and conditions for Sweden's implementation of the Paris Agreement Article 12

The government has requested material that addresses and investigates what we can do today to fulfill the Paris Agreement Article 12, and which gaps need to be closed. The Bolin Centre has the opportunity to get involved. Anna-Karin Nyström will give an update about the process during the next board meeting in May.

g) The corona virus and Bolin Centre activities

Bolin Centre funds used in connection with activities that now are affected by the restrictions imposed in response to the spreading of the Coronavirus can be carried forward to 2021. This means that units within the Bolin Centre can carry funds forward from 2020 to 2021 without any penalties. In addition, the Bolin Centre Climate Festival will be conducted as a virtual event online.
