1. Selection of adjuster

3. Previous minutes

The PhD-board has asked for information about harassment in English. However, it seems like they were unable to find all the information on the webpage due to an earlier ongoing update.

It is unclear whether the power-cut was planned. There are currently three explanations. A change is suggested to the earlier protocol; "There were some incidents", (regarding electronical equipment that failed). The old protocol will be updated with the suggested change (done).

8. Gender equality and equality

9. SAMIR Reports

There has been a SAMIR-report regarding a broken soap-dispenser. Roger will look at it.

Neus remarks that she could not open a door in E2 during the power cut. The door works the same way as during the fire alarm. Neus asks for an investigation. There might be something wrong with the door. Roger describes the line of thought when it comes to fire evacuation.

10. Information from the lab safety network at SU LSN-meeting report from Kicki:

- The section for safety is discussing a suggestion that information in the future will be put on digital boards instead of traditional boards.
- Unfair costs included in the procurement of the caretaking of hazardous waste. If the waste is handed in to the waste room by the institution it will be payed by FA. However, if the institution ordered pick-up of the waste, they have to pay for both the pick-up service and the caretaking of the hazardous waste. Due to this, LSN has asked to take part in the next procurement.
- Swelling lithium-ion batteries can be a fire hazard. Information signs can be put up at places where they are stored. If they start to swell, they should be taken outside, put in a tin bucket and never extinguished with water.
- Acceptance tests of KLARA have started.
- Only Akademiska hus can give permit to grill on university area. The smell may otherwise cause trouble to other institutions.

- Export control: There is a new opportunity for prefects to take a course in export control. However, our researchers don't tent to do experiments abroad very often, so it's not necessary for our institution.

12. Other

Toilet matters: Neus will discuss toilet problem with Lokalgruppen. Munira has a contact regarding cleaning that she will talk to.
