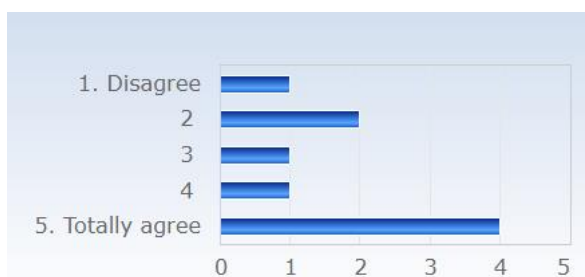

I think the teaching could benefit from a more structural approach. Sometimes, the content of the classes didn't fit in with where we were in the course. It would maybe be better to start with some introductory classes on how to apply the basics of the provisions, and then dive into the details more.

More study visits, more encouraging and engaging seminars

I would like more correction during the seminars.

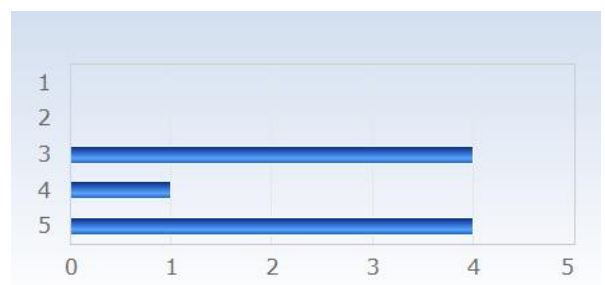

It felt like we started on level 4 out of 10 when we started with the very first lecture, and it seemed like it was a necessity to already know a lot about competition law in order to take this class. This made it very difficult to further on follow the lectures, as you would always fall behind on reading/preparing for seminars. Competition law is a very difficult subject, and I think almost every single person taking the course would benefit from having a "softer start", in regards to giving more of a basic intro to the class before jumping on to the very difficult issues.

I found the lectures about the digital economy a bit difficult to grasp and perhaps a bit cluttered. The one improvement I would suggest would be to try and streamline the lectures about the digital economy and try to make them less abstract.

More explanations on seminar and emphasized the group working.

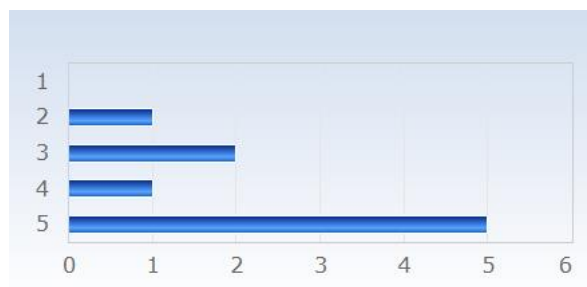

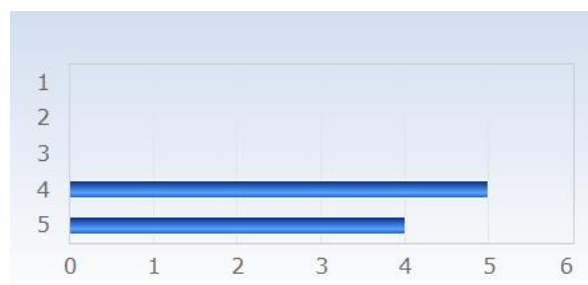
This book really helped me to understand and deepen my learning.

Too many informations on this book, without any boundaries for the reading.

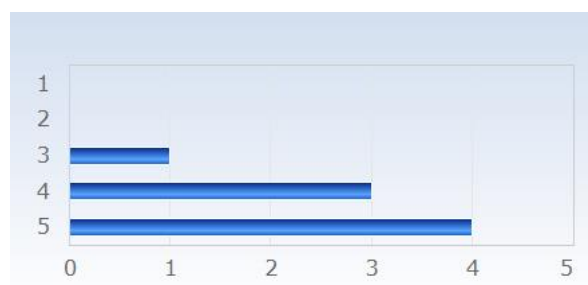

The teaching was very active and concrete.

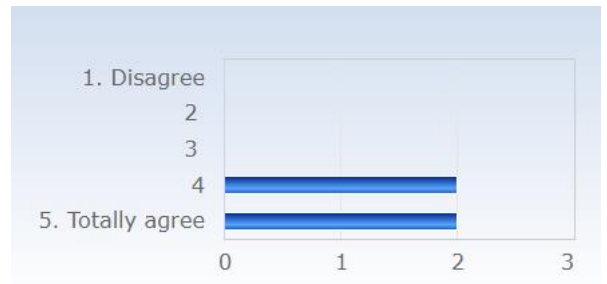

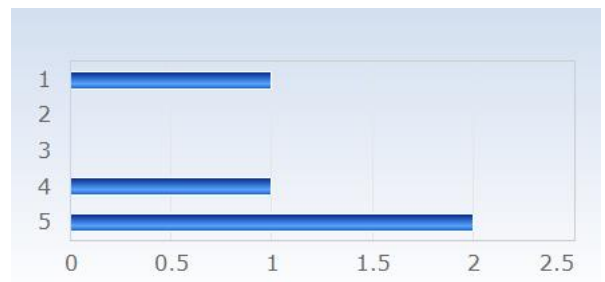
### Comment

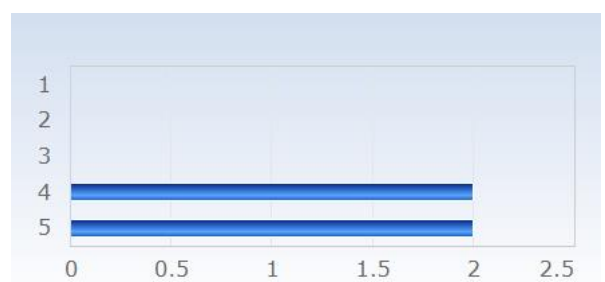
