

Information on Ethical Applications via DO-E:

Changes in Ethical applications via DO-E can be performed when the change <u>does not affect</u> <u>the animals negatively</u>.

Excerpt from The Swedish Board of Agriculture's Regulations And General Advice on Laboratory Animals (L150), CH 5.

§ 6 The Animal Welfare Body may, after application from the principal investigator, decide on amendments of a current ethical approval of animal testing providing that the amendment

- 1. does not risk to affect the welfare of the laboratory animals in a negative way,
- 2. does not affect the possibility to attain the purpose or goal of the experiment,
- 3. does not negatively affect
- a) the experiment's severity classification,
- b) end-point or humane end-point,
- c) experiment times,
- d) laboratory animals' supervision during the animal experiment, as well as
- e) housing, care, or marking that requires approval of an Ethics Committee.

If the Animal Welfare Body deems that the amendment of the ethical approval does not fulfill the conditions in the first paragraph, the Animal Welfare Body shall decline the case.

Examples of changes that can be performed via the DO-E free of charge is:

- adding a new facility to your permit,
- changing the principal investigator,
- changing something in the experimental design that does not affect the animals negatively.

Examples of changes that cannot be performed via the DO-E is:

- Adding more animals to the permit,
- adding more procedures to the experimental design,
- increase the severity classification,
- increase end-point.

The DO-E require that the application is submitted 1 month before the meeting. The application should be read by the Föreståndare (*Named Animal Care and Welfare Officer-NACWO*) and submitted to the DO-E (<u>DO-E.mbw@su.se</u>) no later than 1 month before the meeting. Please attach the latest approved ethical permit you wish to change, including any addendums. If you provide the DO-E with the incorrect Dnr (such as a Dnr that has subsequently had an approved change by the Ethics committee), your application will not be approved by the DO-E.

- The application must be in Swedish.
- A physical copy if the signed original application must be sent to "Irja Ruben,
 Institutionen f\u00f6r molekyl\u00e4r biovetenskap Wenner-Grens institut, 106 91 Stockholm", or
 be left in Irjas postbox in the post room at F3.
