More organised in terms of the lectures and also more information on the exam layout.


The schedule and arrangement of lecturers should be improved. The schedule was tight during few weeks before the exam. After the deadline for case study, there were problem-based seminar, essay and exam. We were given the case for the seminar only few days in advance while the deadlines for the essay and exam were right after the seminar. Furthermore, I notice some of our lecturers were assigned just few days before our lecturers. This left me an impression that the lectures and the course in general were not organized well. Also, at the time I'm doing this survey (20 Oct), we haven't received our scores.




