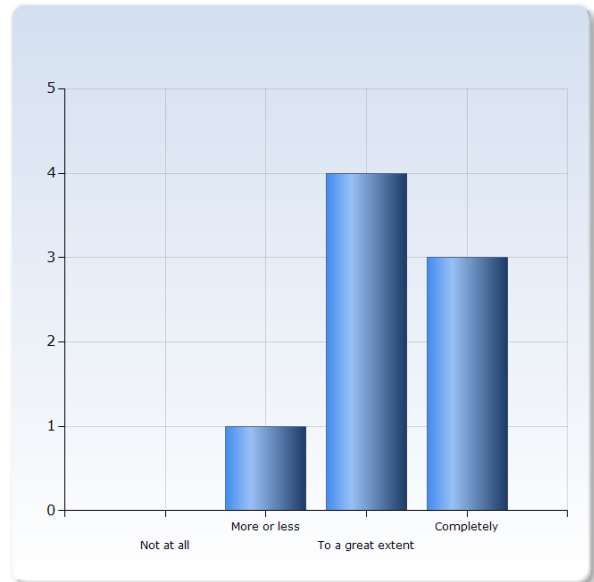

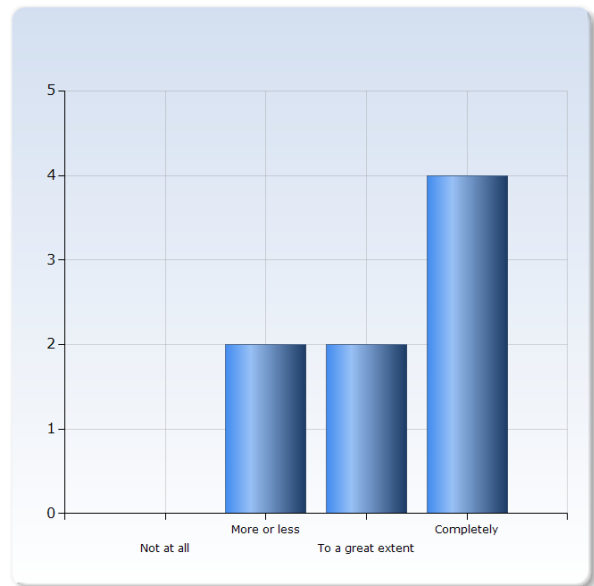


Comment

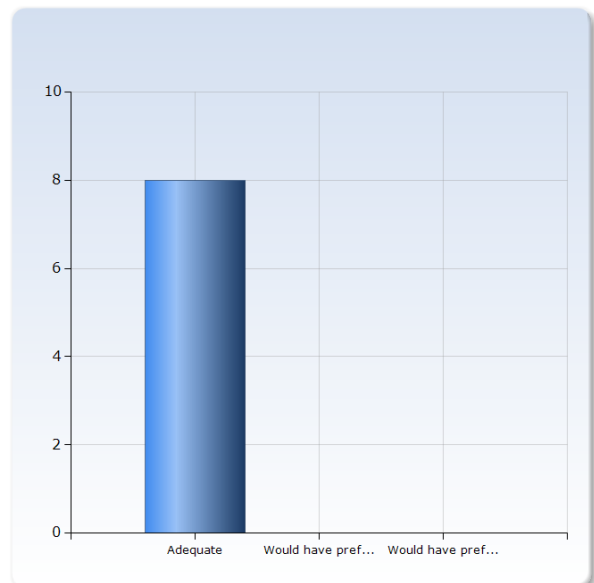


Comment

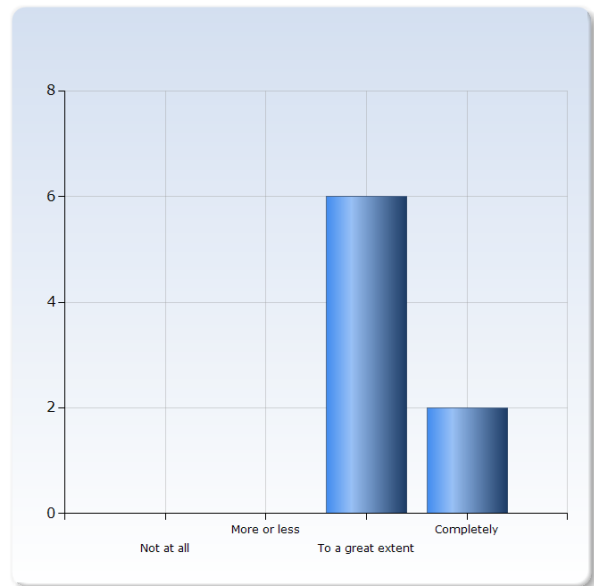


Comment

Would be useful to have a course book, like a book specifically written for this course. For example, it was hard to find information useful from an arbitrators point of view - most texts are written to help the parties seeking information

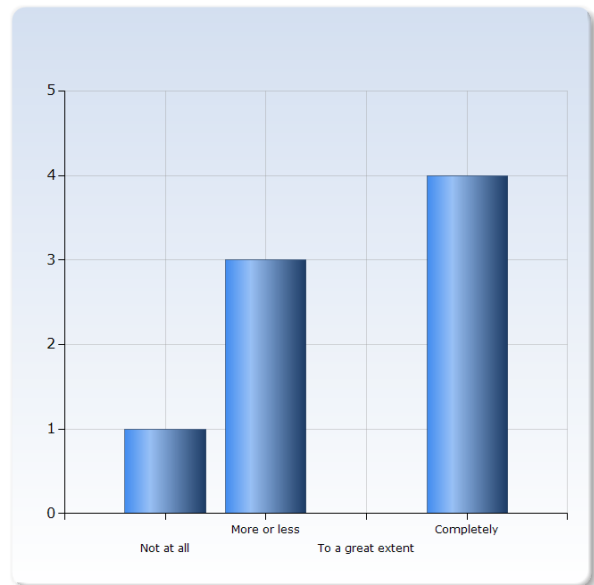

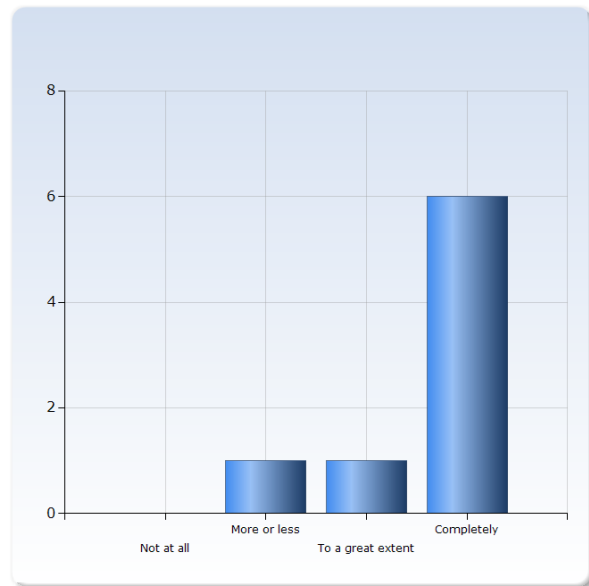


Comment

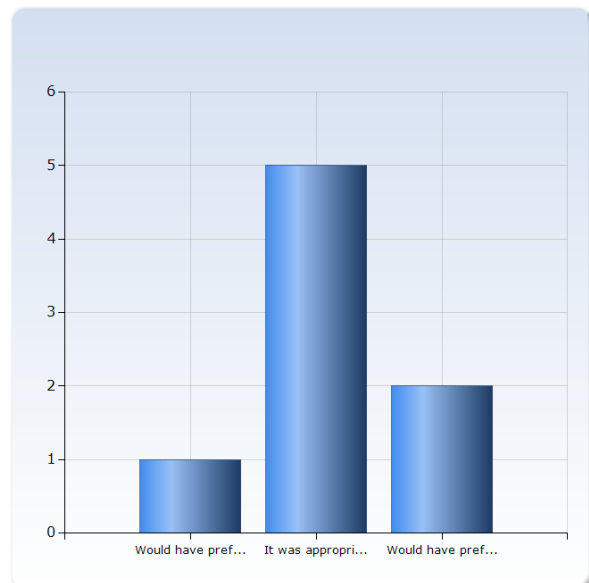


Comment

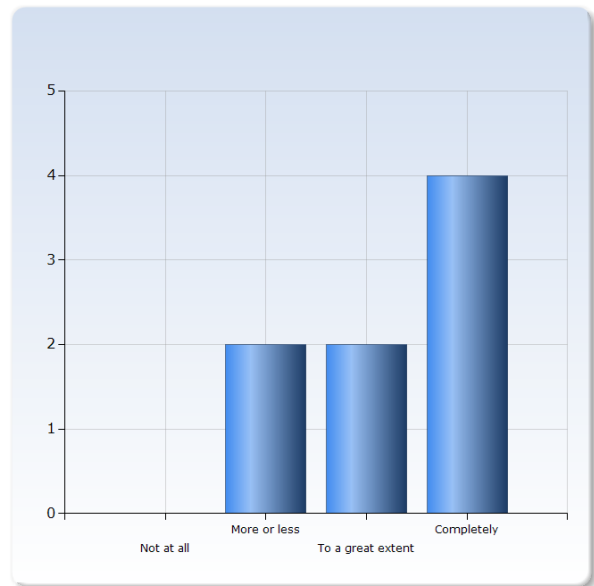


Comment

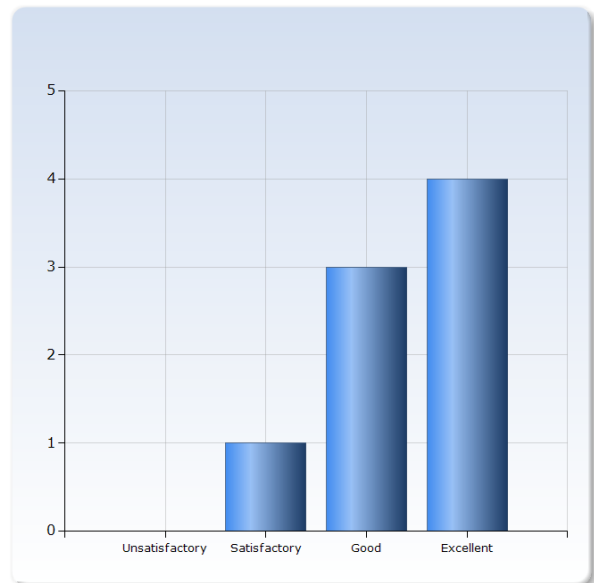

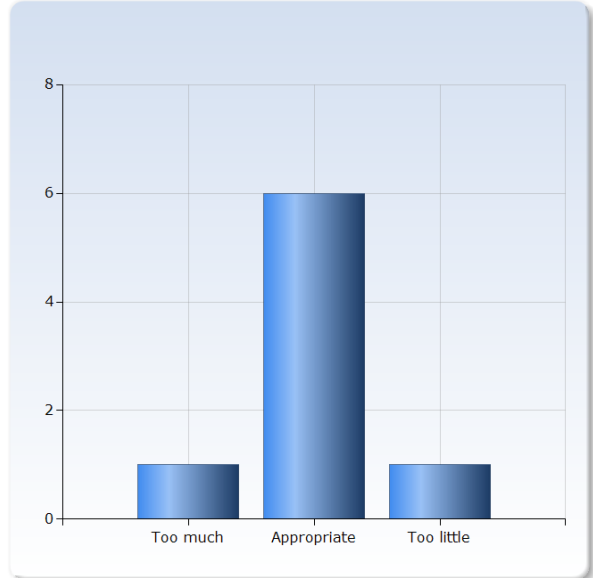

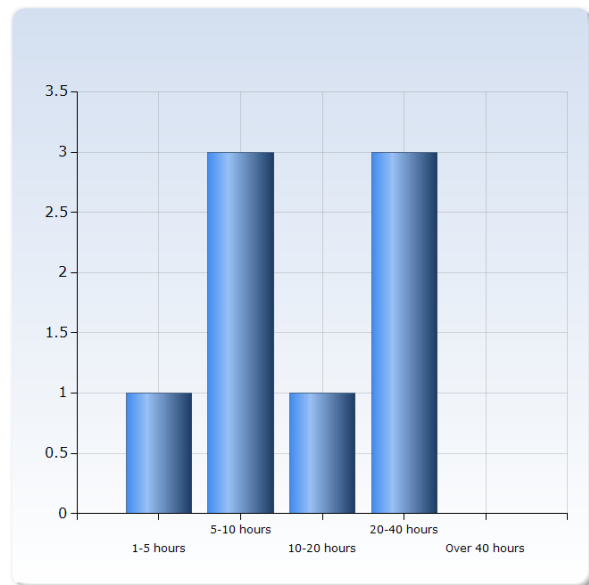

The picture painted to us the first days of the course was so much worse then what we actually had to do

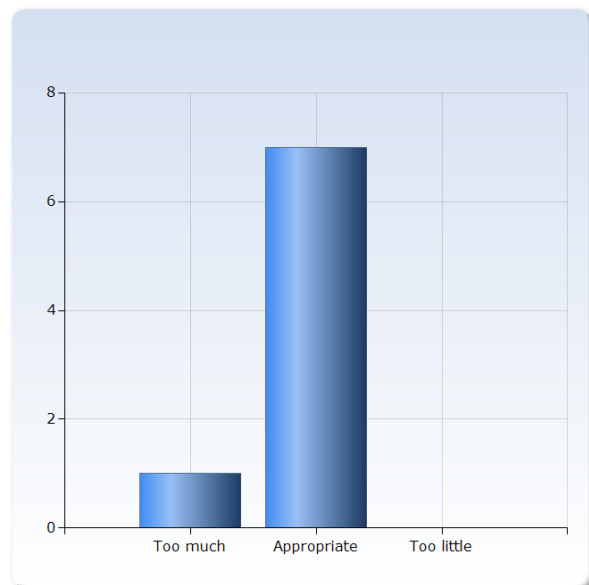

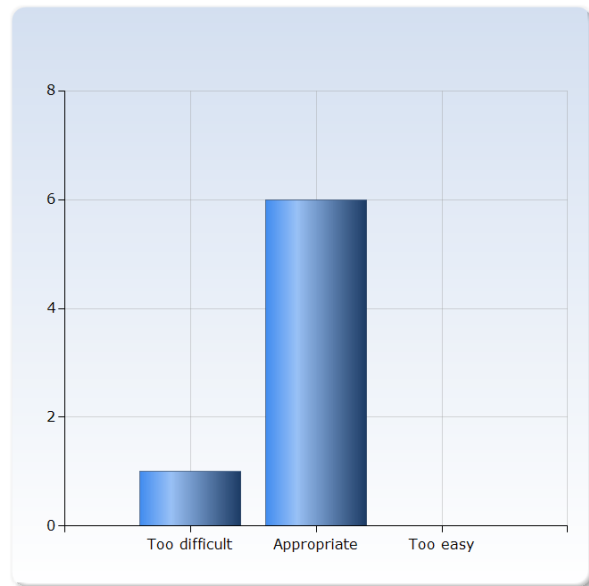

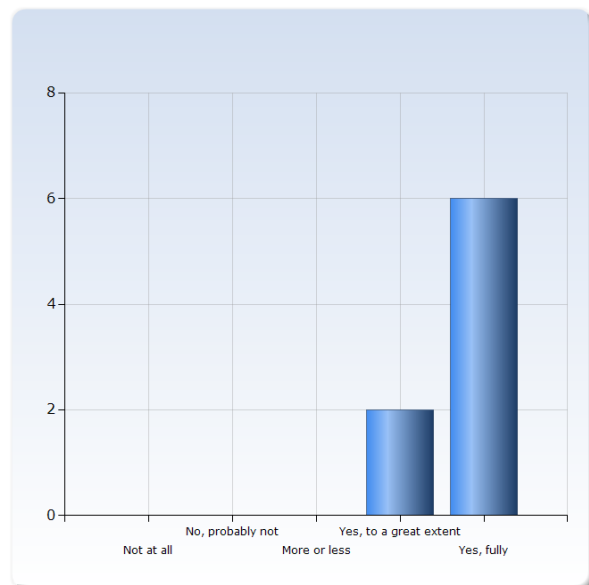

I am unable to answer this without having seen a result and knowing what was expected compared to the effort put in.

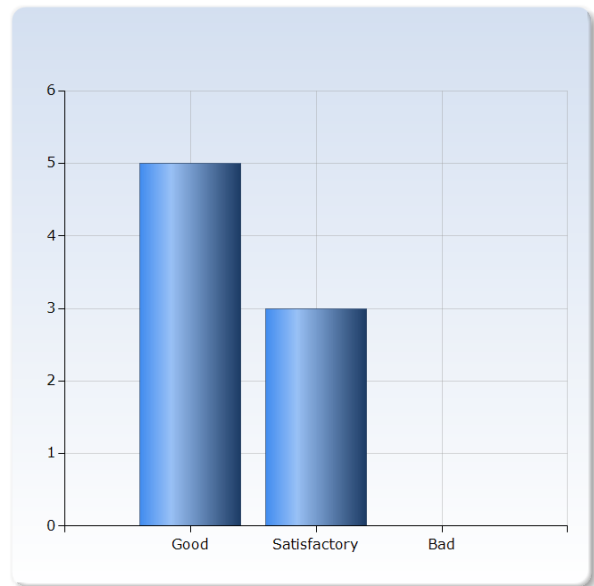

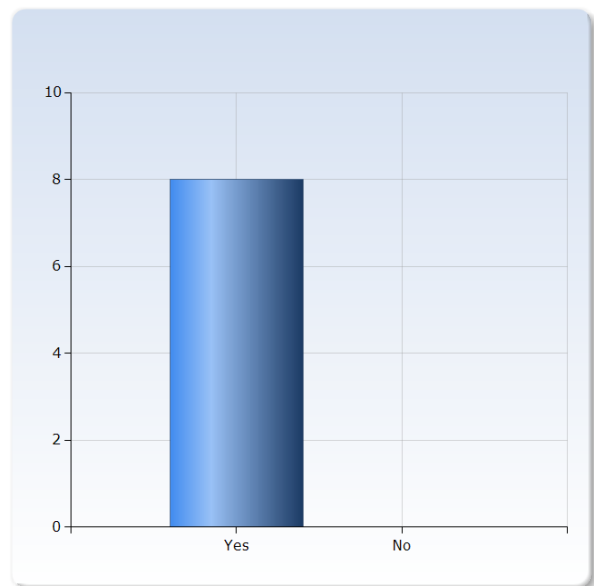
