Course report

EU Internal Market Law, 15 ECT, Spring semester 2023, JU347A and JU347B

After the pandemic, we noted a decline in the number of students applying for this optional course and the cohort reached a minimum in 2023 with only eight participants. There are several reasons for this, and one contributing factor is the installment of a similar course during the Autumn term that is also combined with the master program in European economic law. It must be said that the few course evaluations received were very positive. Almost all aspects of the course were rated four or five at the five-graded scale. This evaluation was confirmed when speaking with some of the students after the course. they expressed their appreciation of a rather complete curriculum. As to critique, one student considered some of the study material to be old and that some of the power point presentations could be better structured. However, it should be mentioned that the course is certainly up to date and a significant segment of the learning activities is devoted to the digital internal market, AI and data exchanges. Considering the positive evaluations throughout the years it is a pity that the Institution decided to pause the course because of the low number of participants.

As a weakness one student commented that the material for some lectures could be updated and better structured. Having said that, the engagement and the student's learning curves were impressive. All students succeeded to write a comprehensive paper in internal market law which is quite an achievement. It was only too few participants this year which could be changed. Naturally we are happy for all the positive feed-back and interesting discussions we had.

Because of the low number of participants in 2023 the course in internal market law has been paused.





Updated powerpoints with a more clear red thread, it was sometimes hard to understand what the slides was related to. Having more lessons on some basic topics




