The strengths of the course's according to the students

The satisfaction with the course was high. What has been mentioned in the feedback was the content of the course, engaged teachers, the combination of teaching theory and practice and the different activities and tasks employed in the teaching – especially the mock arbitration. Also, the guest lectures have been greatly appreciated. Access to online resources has also been mentioned as an advantage. The participants in the course are partly Swedish students and partly practitioners which adds an interesting perspective in the discussions.

The weaknesses of the course according to the students

One issue that was pointed out as an area that could be improved was the format of the exam and the other comment proposed less obligatory seminars.

Teachers' comments

We find that the course's structure, workload, examination and literature work really well. The only change that is foreseen for the next year is to provide more clarity regarding the requirements of the exam.
