

Course report, Swedish law in Context, Spring 2024

The course provides an overview of the Swedish legal system. It has had the same basic structure for several years, but minor changes are made every semester. The last semester has put more emphasis on constitutional law, especially freedom of speech issues to reflect international interest in, e.g., Sweden's handling of Quran burnings. A new feature of the course is a study visit to the Medieombudsman (Allmänhetens medieombudsman).

Only three out of 18 students answered the course evaluation, which amounts to 17 %. From the course evaluations and student feedback during the semester, it seems that the students are generally satisfied with the course. The structure of the teaching of the course – where each seminar or lecture takes up different subjects – is appreciated by the students, as it gives insights into many areas of the law.

One line of feedback regarding what could be improved is that the written test at the end of the course should better reflect topics that the course literature puts focus on. This feedback is valuable and will be kept in mind for the coming semester.

The teaching of the course will be affected by the general guidelines from the Law Faculty that most teachers should be faculty members and not external lawyers. This will be noticed in the autumn semester of 2024.

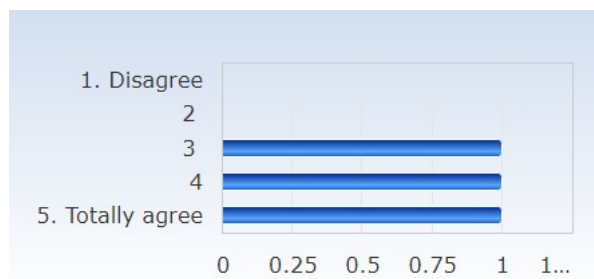

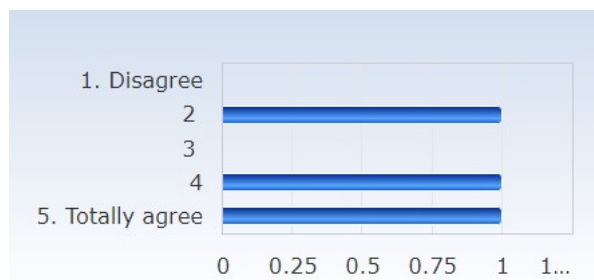

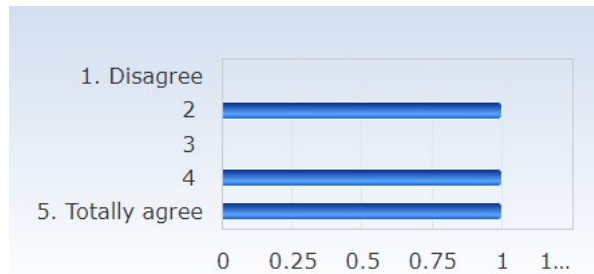

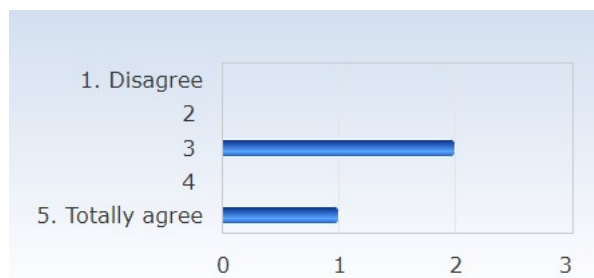
