



## Course syllabus for third-cycle level course

#### **Decision**

This syllabus was adopted by the assistant head of department 2021-05-11.

#### **Entry requirements**

Admitted to a third-cycle program in language education or other applicable subject.

#### **Content**

The course addresses current issues and disputed research findings regarding language learning and their implications for language teaching. Current language education research on the learning and teaching of first, second and foreign languages are studied and discussed. Relationships between contested issues and areas in language education and teaching practices in various context are examined. Policy documents from different language teaching contexts are analysed and compared based on current language education research.

#### **Learning outcomes**

Upon successful completion of the course students should be able to:

- apply critical perspectives on current issues in language education research and practice,
- analyse and problematize current language education research on the learning and teaching of first, second and foreign languages,
- evaluate and discuss policy documents for language teaching based on relevant language education research and their own experiences. ....

## **Compulsory activities**

Obligatory attendance at all scheduled activities.

## **Forms of examination**

Oral presentations and written assignments

Grading is done according to a two-grade scale:

G = (Godkânt) Pass

U = (Underkânt) Fail

## **Forms of teaching**

Seminars either on campus or online (this is decided for each course iteration).

## **Transitional provisions**

When the course is discontinued, or the course content is substantially changed, students have the right to be examined according to this syllabus once a term during a three term period.

## **Limitations**

The course may not be part of a degree together with a course with identical or similar content.

## **Course literature**
