1. Entry requirements

Admitted to doctoral studies in psychology

2. Learning outcomes

Upon completion of the course, the doctoral student is expected to being able to:

1. ... produce effective presentations using slides as well as poster presentations of their research findings in English for an academic audience;
2. ... master good presentation techniques to effectively present their research in different contexts (oral communication, poster, mingle, lay audience);
3. ... actively and constructively contribute to a research discussion

3. Content

Lectures and seminars on research presentation during two weeks. This also includes preparation of the assignments and peer-tutoring.

4. Forms of examination

The course is examined by:

- 1) An oral presentation;
- 2) A poster presentation;
- 3) An elevator pitch;
- 4) A free-format presentation aimed at a lay audience;
- 5) Constructive discussion during an oral presentation.

5. Form of instruction

Teaching consists of lectures, seminars, and own presentations at seminars.
