1. Entry requirements

Upon completion of the course, the doctoral student is expected to being able to:

1. ... master good presentation techniques to effectively present their research in different contexts (oral communication, poster, mingle, lay audience);
2. ... actively and constructively contribute to a research discussion

2. Learning outcomes

Upon completion of the course, the doctoral student is expected to being able to:

1. ... produce effective presentations using slides as well as poster presentations of their research findings in English for an academic audience;
2. ... master good presentation techniques to effectively present their research in different contexts (oral communication, poster, mingle, lay audience);
3. ... actively and constructively contribute to a research discussion

3. Content

- 1) Participation in at least 10 research seminars and presentation clubs;

- 2) Active participation in the discussion at one of the research seminars (not on own research data);
- 3) Presentation of own research data at one of the research seminars;
- 4) Presentation at a presentation club.

The research seminars shall be intended for a research audience and shall be organized at Swedish or international universities (on-site or online), and target a larger group than the doctoral student's own research group (at least at the division level at the Department of Psychology).

4. Forms of examination

The course is examined by:

- 1) Description of the seminar (topic, date, duration, location) and signature of seminar leader or supervisor for each participation;
- 2) Short report on the discussion;
- 3) Short report on presentation at seminar;
- 4) Short report on presentation at the presentation club.

5. Form of instruction

Teaching consists of seminars and presentations at seminars.
