Learning outcomes

For a Pass the student is expected to:

1. – be able to use some common everyday Swedish words and phrases correctly,
2. – be able to apply rules for Swedish word order in statements and questions and be able to conduct basic conversations by asking and answering questions about everyday topics.

Passed

The student can in general on the whole

1. – use some common everyday Swedish words and phrases in the correct inflected form,
2. – apply rules for Swedish word order in statements and questions correctly and conduct simple conversations by asking and answering questions about everyday topics correctly.

Failed

The student fails to demonstrate that he/she is able

1. – to use some common everyday Swedish words and phrases in the correct inflected form, and/or
2. – to apply rules for Swedish word order in statements and questions correctly into practise and to conduct basic conversations by asking and answering questions about everyday topics correctly.

The student has not participated in the written examination and can therefore not be allocated a grade.
